

- **Preeminent in Any Form of Conflict**




Why a Joint Vision?

- **CJCS Title 10 responsibility** to assist NCA “in providing for the strategic direction of the armed forces
- Provide a **common direction** to harmonize Service views and guide their force development efforts
- **Advance joint warfighting capability** as intended by the Goldwater-Nichols Defense Reorganization Act

A concept-based statement of the operational capabilities required to satisfy a Joint Force Commander's needs in 2010 and beyond and meet 21st Century Challenge requirements. A fully articulated DOC is expressed in terms of subordinate tasks, associated conditions, criteria for measurement, and potential means to accomplish the task.

Used by ACOM as basis for their experimentation plan

- Provides guidance on national security policy and objectives

CJCS

- Assists President/SecDef in providing for the strategic direction of the military
- Develops doctrine for the joint employment of the armed forces
- Formulates policy for joint training and coordinating the military education and training of armed forces

SecDef

- Responsible for **JV 2010 implementation**
- **Oversees USCINACOM joint experimentation program**
- **Oversees USCINACOM joint concept development**

- **Executive Agent for Joint Experimentation**

- **Recommend** to CJCS joint concepts/capabilities for further assessment/JE


USACOM Joint Warfighting Experimentation Charter



USCINCACOM ***Champions Future Joint Warfighting Capabilities***

- ***Executive Agent for joint warfighting experimentation (JWE)***
 - ***Experimentation supports JV 2010 implementation***
 - ***Design, prepare, conduct and assess JWE***
 - ***Leverage DOD experimentation activities***
- ***Joint Concept Development***
 - ***Create and explore new joint warfighting concepts and capabilities***
 - ***Integrate and assess concepts from Services, CINCs and other sources***
 - ***Services retain primary responsibility to develop concepts, conduct experimentation within core competencies***
- ***Recommend future joint warfighting requirements in DOTMLP terms***






Desired Operational Concepts
